Agni-V: A Technological Marvel

India has announced a major milestone in its missile technology. On March 11, 2024, the DRDO successfully tested an Agni missile that can carry multiple warheads and hit multiple targets simultaneously. The test, named Mission Divyastra, was hailed as a significant achievement by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. In a tweet, he expressed his pride in the DRDO scientists for developing the Agni-V missile with Multiple Independently Targetable



Re-entry Vehicle (MIRV) technology. This test has demonstrated India's growing capabilities in missile technology and its commitment to national security.

With a range exceeding 5,000 kilometers, the Agni-V missile can reach much of Asia, including northern China. Some parts of Europe could also potentially be within its strike zone.

The MIRV technology is a type of ballistic missile payload that operates beyond the Earth's atmosphere and comprises multiple warheads capable of targeting specific locations. While this concept is typically associated with intercontinental ballistic missiles carrying thermonuclear warheads, it is not solely limited to them. Several countries, including the United States, the United Kingdom, France, China, and Russia, have already incorporated MIRV missiles into their military arsenals.

Quoting a government source, "This system is equipped with indigenous avionics systems and high accuracy sensor packages, which ensure that the vehicles reach the target points within the desired accuracy. Their capability is an annunciator of India's growing technological prowess". They also mentioned that the project had a significant contribution by women.

Agni-V had its first flight test with MIRV, while Agni-I to IV missiles have already been deployed with ranges from 700-3,500 km. This successful test reinforces India's position as a leading force in missile technology. India has the potential to become a global leader in missile technology if it continues to invest in research and development, expand its resources, and leverage its knowledge. Given the adequate resources and time, India can make significant strides in this field and establish itself as a leading player.

Indian Farmers Revive Protest Movement: A Year On, Their Resilience Shines Through the Roads

The 'Delhi Chalo' protest has been in full swing since February 13th, 2024. Thousands of farmers from Punjab, Haryana, and Western Uttar Pradesh have been marching towards Delhi to assert their demands. Their primary demand is a legal guarantee for Minimum Support Price (MSP). MSP is the lowest rate at which the government procurement agencies buy crops from farmers. It shields farmers from market fluctuation, offering stability and income security. Apart from the demand for enforcing MSP, they have been voicing their concerns for implementation of the Swaminathan Commision pension for farmers, debt relief, and withdrawing cases against previous protestors.



The protest initially started in the year 2020. Farmers Unions said that these laws would leave the growers vulnerable to big companies and destroy their livelihood. After months of insisting that the reforms would benefit farmers, the Prime Minister on November 19th, 2021, announced that his government would repeal the laws. After a few days, the Parliament passed a bill to cancel all the reforms.



The move was hailed as a victory for farmers, but they did not stop the protest until the government gave them the official letter stating acceptance of their demands. The government also agreed to provide compensation to the families of farmers who died during the protest. Now, the farmers are back on roads, alleging that the government has not kept the promises made during the last protest. They are demanding penalization of all those who sell fake agricultural products, along with doubling the number of working days under the rural employment guarantee scheme to 200, which is 100 currently.

Despite the persistence and resilience shown by the farming community, their demands remain unmet, highlighting the concerning lack of effective dialogue and action from authorities. The prolonged nature of these protests serves as a poignant reminder of the pressing need for meaningful reforms and an equitable solution to address the challenges faced by our farmers.

On Sunday, March 17, 2024, faculty members from Mahindra University organised a field trip to the H.E.H Nizam's Museum in Purani Haveli, Hyderabad, for the students enrolled in the third-year B.Tech elective course titled "Incredible India: A Historical Journey Through Food, Culture & Material Objects." The course instructor, Professor Paromita Das Gupta, and her colleagues, Professor Imtiaz Quadri and Professor Aparna Singh, led the day trip. The course focuses on exploring iconic Indian objects, highlighting the rich histories behind these everyday items that are often overlooked by many Indians. These objects range from common household items like Amul butter, Chyawanprash, Paan, and Bata shoes to precious artefacts in private or state museums, collectively contributing to India's unique identity through centuries of

The field trip to the H.E.H Nizam's Museum began in the morning, with 94

students arriving at the museum by 10:30 a.m., after navigating through the bustling streets of the Old City. The museum, located inside a 300-year-old palace within the Haveli complex, also functioning as an educational institution, provides insights into the luxurious lifestyle and collections of the Nizams. This offers a glimpse into Hyderabad's history from ancient times to the present day. As visitors climbed the well-preserved 150-year-old wooden stairs to enter the museum, they encountered a range of exquisite artefacts, including a golden throne and cradle used by the seventh Nizam, Osman Ali, a 150-year-old manually operated lift and silver replicas of iconic buildings from Hyderabad's heritage. Apart from such extravagant pieces, the students also got to see a diamond-studded golden tiffin box valued at over ₹100 crores of silver and gold crockery used daily by the Nizams, including a tea cup, which is supposed to change colour in the presence of poison. The world's largest two-tier



walk-in wardrobe with individual changing rooms was also present in this museum. The guides passionately shared insights into the daily lives of the Nizams, shedding light on aspects often overshadowed by grandeur. The students returned to campus enriched with captivating knowledge about the Nizams' possessions, reflecting India's rich cultural heritage. The objective of this field trip was successfully achieved by exposing students to the hidden treasures of a princely state that may not always receive attention, when compared to more mainstream and popular tourist destinations.

A Former Professor at DU, GN Saibaba, Was Cleared of Any Maoist Affiliations. What Was the Antithesis?

The Bombay High Court's Nagpur Bench acquitted former Delhi University Professor G.N. Saibaba and five others in a Maoist linkages case under the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA) on Tuesday, stating that the prosecution failed to establish the case against them beyond a reasonable doubt. After failing to convince the High Court to delay the judgement enforcement, the Maharashtra Government sought the Supreme Court within hours, requesting an urgent hearing.

The life sentence that was given to Prof. Saibaba and the other accused—Mahesh Tirki, Hem Mishra, Pandu Narote, Vijay Tirki, and Prashant Rahi—by a sessions court in 2017 was also overturned by a Division Bench of Justices Vinay Joshi and Valmiki S.A. Menezes. The prosecution's sanction under the UAPA was declared "null and void".

On October 14, 2022, a Bombay High Court presided over by Justice Rohit B. Deo also found Prof. Saibaba and the other five suspects not guilty. However, the Supreme Court immediately overturned the decision, requesting that the case be reopened.

Advocate-General Birendra Saraf asked the High Court to postpone the implementation of its ruling for six weeks so that the government may file an appeal with the Supreme Court shortly after the ruling was rendered on Tuesday. But the Bench declined to issue a stay. "The accused have already been found not guilty, and we have

ordered their immediate release if it is not necessary in any other situation". The court said, "We cannot stall the said order, which may affect the right to personal liberty."

The court stated that the prosecution had not been able to "establish any legal seizure or any incrimination material against the accused". According to the law, the trial court's decision is unsustainable. As a result, we accept the appeals and vacate the challenged decision. "Everyone who was accused is cleared." Following that, the Maharashtra government appealed to the Supreme Court on Tuesday.

In a case involving connections to Maoist organizations, a combined team of the Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, and Intelligence Bureau detained wheelchair-bound professor Saibaba on May 19, 2014, while he was returning home from Delhi University. Since his 2014 arrest in connection with the case, he has been housed at the Nagpur Central Jail.

Prof. Saibaba and five other defendants were found guilty in March 2017 by a sessions court in Gadchiroli, Maharashtra, of engaging in actions that amounted to waging war against the nation. They were also found guilty of having Naxal literature, which they intended to distribute among Gadchiroli locals and underground Naxalites in an effort to incite violence. Prof. Saibaba had filed an appeal in the Bombay High Court based on the sessions court's accusations under Section 45(1) of

the UAPA. There, a bench led by Justice Deo also found him and the other five not guilty, alleging procedural errors. "A civil democracy cannot sacrifice procedural safeguards afforded to the accused, even though terrorism poses an ominous threat to national security and every legitimate weapon in the armoury must be deployed against it," the Bench had stated.

But the very next day, the High Court did not take into account "the merits of the case including the gravity of the offence," according to a special bench of the Supreme Court made up of Justice M.R. Shah, a retired judge, and Justice Bela M. Trivedi. Vasantha Kumari, the wife of Prof. Saibaba, welcomed the ruling on Tuesday and stated that her husband's name was never in jeopardy because everyone who knew him always had faith in him. Although we are really relieved, we are unsure of what lies ahead at this time. In 2022, he was found not guilty either, although the ruling was contested. We'll be worried until he returns home to this place," she remarked in Delhi.

It further stated that no evidence of accusing the accused could be proven, and the prosecution was unable to demonstrate a legal basis for the seizure of materials. Consequently, the bench granted the appeals against the trial court's decision to find the accused guilty, overturning the judgement and clearing the accused of all charges for "being unsustainable in the hands of law."

France's Gift to Women on International Women's Day

On International Women's Day this year, the world saw France take an enormous step towards women's rights and reproductive health by sealing abortion as a constitutional right. This constitutional amendment in Article 34 of the French Constitution was officially sealed by the Justice Minister, Eric Dupond-Moretti, along with the French President, Emmanuel Macron, with hot wax and a 19th-century printing press on Friday, 8th March, 2024, in Paris.

This influential move has made France the first country in the world to explicitly guarantee abortion rights to women. The sealing of this right received immense support from both the houses of the French Parliament, as well as feminists from around the world. Abortion has been legal in France since 1975, but Macron decided to make it a constitutional right after observing the USA overturn their 50-year-old Roe v. Wade law regarding the right to abortion, leaving it to the states to decide the abortion laws on their own.

Establishing abortion as a constitutional

right ensures that no sudden change will be made to the law, guaranteeing freedom of women for centuries to come. Macron believes that this was the first step to fighting for the rights of women in Europe, where countries are divided entirely on abortion rights. "Today is not the end of a story, but the start of a fight," said Macron at the public ceremony. "We are going to lead this fight in our continent, in our Europe, where reactionary forces are attacking women's rights before attacking the rights of minorities," he announced.

In the European Union, some countries, such as Malta and Poland, have very restrictive rights on abortion, such as only allowing abortion when the mother's life is in danger. The French President believes that he can change this by serving as an example towards progressiveness in the EU. With France taking a huge step towards women's rights, it now falls on the other countries to also promote progressiveness, especially regarding the freedom and rights of women around the world.

Bengaluru's Dry Spell: From Garden City to Parched City

Once known for its lush gardens, Bengaluru, the country's Silicon Valley stares at the unthinkable reality of Day Zero. Driven by job opportunities, this city has attracted a surge of tech talent from across the country. However, a looming water crisis threatens to disrupt this ecosystem as people want to work from home and relocate.

The River Kaveri and groundwater levels have not been able to fulfill the Moreover, there was scanty rainfall in 2023, requirements this time for Bangalore. Digging borewells to quench the needs of everyone flocking to Bengaluru has depleted the groundwater levels starkly. attributed to the El Niño Effect by the Indian Meteorological Department. All these dominoes have culminated in Bengaluru's predicament today and the natural sources can no longer yield here.

Amid this distress, hotels and resorts are offering Holi pool parties and rain dances. It is alarming to notice the careless attitude exhibited by such stays, with lavish parties that go on for days. But on a positive note, the Bannerghatta Biological Park, which houses 8 lakes, is untouched by water woes. Moreover, the park is supplying tankers to nearby localities apart from assuaging the

One of the other lake cities in South India

which has witnessed such encroachments is Hyderabad, sharing the similarities of IT and migration with Bengaluru. Madhulika Choudhary, a lake activist, has revived the Neknampur lake in Hyderabad using the 'floating island' technique, which has plants that absorb high nitrogen and phosphorus from sewage water. Bengaluru authorities are also trying to implicate this model to

Municipalities around the globe should take

notes from Bengaluru's missteps so that such a nightmare never plays out again. Sustainable development is always better than concrete jungles and fully paved roads. "Keregalam Kattu, Marangalam Nedu" translates to "Build lakes, plant trees". The legend goes that this advice was given to Bengaluru's founder Kempegowda by his mother in the 1500s. These ancient words of wisdom must be taken seriously today so that our cities thrive.



India Stuns With 8.4% Q3 GDP Growth, Surpasses Estimates

The Indian economy has witnessed a robust GDP growth of 8.4% in Q3FY24, as per information released by the Ministry of Statistics and Data Implementation (MOSPI). This number is a 6 quarter-high and has beaten economists' predictions of 6.6%. It also represents a significant increase from the previous quarter's 7.6%.

The GDP figures for the first and second quarters of the current year have been revised to 8.2% and 8.1%, from 7.8% and 7.6% respectively. The National Statistics Office (NSO) has witnessed a growth rate of 7.6% for FY24, up from the previous ballpark of 7.3%.

In the December quarter, industries fared well with a 10.4% growth. The manufacturing and construction sectors saw an upsurge of 11.6% YoY and 9.5% YoY respectively, signifying the strong role of public capex. The services sector has also experienced a steady rise. The agriculture, forestry and fishing sector has declined by 0.8% and private consumption has only risen by 3.5%. Government spending has diminished sharply by 3.2% in Q3, having grown 13.2% in Q2. Growth in the Indian economy is being driven by vigorous public capex growth.

GDP measures the total value of all goods and services produced within the borders of a country over a specific period, typically annually or quarterly. It includes all final goods and services produced for consumption, investment, government



spending, and net exports (exports minus imports). GVA focuses solely on the value added at each stage of production. GVA is simply GDP excluding indirect taxes and subsidies.

India's GVA growth in Q3FY24 toned down to 6.5%, from 8.2% in Q1FY24 and 7.7% in Q2FY24. Experts have expressed concerns about the discrepancy between GDP and GVA as they feel that the GDP does not entirely reflect a rise in the production of new goods or the value of services rendered. It is possible that a rise in indirect taxes, like the Goods and Services Tax (GST), could be inflating the GDP figure.

Japan and the UK have slipped into recession, which is slightly concerning for Indian exports. Nevertheless, our numbers are good news as the rest of the world is struggling for any growth at all. The RBI may limit inflation given such positive boosts. Estimates for FY 25 are also looking bright for India, indicating a growth in the economy.

Culinary Hotspot Rameshwaram Café in Bengaluru Rocked by Suspected Terror Attack

On Friday, March 1, 2024, an explosion Bengaluru's renowned Rameshwaram Café in Brookfield. The establishment, celebrated for its delectable cuisine, has piqued the interest of culinary enthusiasts nationwide with its vibrant online presence. Initially, it was surmised that the blast stemmed from a gas cylinder leak, but further probing confirmed suspicions. Subsequently, Siddaramaiah, the Chief Minister of Karnataka, announced that a low-intensity improvised explosive device (IED) was the culprit behind the detonation, resulting in at least nine individuals sustaining injuries from the explosion.

Pertaining to the IED explosion, the Bengaluru Central Crime Branch



apprehended four individuals on Saturday. According to the authorities, they are almost certain regarding the identity of the primary accused in the case. An image of the suspected bomber from CCTV footage was disseminated by the National Investigation Agency (NIA). The bomber was captured on camera entering and exiting the café premises while donning a mask, a cap, and glasses. He vacated the premises within nine minutes without partaking in his food, and mere minutes after his departure, the explosive device detonated. In their investigation of the IED bomb explosion at the Rameshwaram Café, the NIA unveiled four new images of the bomber and asked for public assistance in identifying the suspect, offering a bounty of INR 10 lakhs to any individual who might recognise him.

Preliminary investigation and forensic analysis of the IED utilized in the Rameshwaram Café blast indicate the possibility of an ISIS cell from the Shivamogga region of the state, which had been on the radar of security agencies as early as 2020, to be involved. In the Shivamogga case, Abdul Mateen Ahmed Taha and Mussabir Hussain Shazeb are the

two primary missing suspects.

According to reports, Taha and Shahzeb are affiliated with a broader ISIS network in South India as well as the numerous Shivamogga module members. The NIA has apprehended a significant suspect in the bomb investigation, and Shabbir, the suspect, was arrested from the Bellary district of Karnataka. The case is still under investigation, and the citizens are curious to know what might be revealed next.

GPUs: From Gaming Rigs to The Mind of The Machine

From their humble beginnings as graphical accelerator cards to render games and frames, Graphical Processing Units (GPUs) have come a long way and are now the driving force behind the rapid advancements in AI. Their ability to perform massive parallel computations pushed boundaries of what was once thought to be possible.

Most of the "AI" that most of us use every day such as LLMs work based on deep learning techniques. Although the term Deep Learning (DL) was coined in the 80s, there was no significant progress in the field till the mid-2000s due to the math heavy nature of Dl and computation associated for it. Researchers began exploring parallel processing power of GPUs for accelerating the training of neural networks and other DL based algorithms around 2007. It was not until the 2012 ImageNet challenge, where a deep learning model powered by two GTX580 GPUs beat image recognition benchmarks by a landslide, that the world realized the true potential of these specialized chips.

GPUs offer significant advantages over CPUs due to their highly parallel architecture which is well suited for the matrix and vector operations which are commonly found in DL applications.

This led to an increased adoption rate of GPUs for DL tasks, especially as the models grew in size and complexity. Nvidia, the GPU Titan (pun intended) played a significant role in this trend by developing Compute Unified Device Architecture (CUDA), a parallel computing platform and API that allowed developers to harness the power of Nvidia GPUs for ML tasks, giving rise to ML frameworks like PyTorch and TensorFlow that are now industry standard.

Today, Nvidia still holds a significant advantage in the deep learning (DL) market. However, the competitive landscape is dynamic, with AMD's ROCm platform being a compelling alternative. Tech giants like Amazon, Google and Meta are investing in building these specialized chips of their own , hoping to gain an upper hand.

AI and GPU development are locked in a cycle of mutual development. AI's hunger for computation drives GPU innovation, while faster GPUs allow for more complex AI models. This intertwined development cycle promises to push the boundaries of what's possible with artificial intelligence. The future's looking bright indeed!





Was Singapore an 'Anti-Hero' For Striking an **Exclusive Deal with Taylor Swift?**

Singapore government provided Taylor Swift an incentive stating that Singapore has to be the only stop in south-east Asia for her world tour. Their Prime minister Lee Hsien Loong defended this offer by saying it was not a bitter move towards its neighbours.

"Our agencies negotiated an arrangement with her to come to Singapore and perform and make this as her only stop in south-east Asia," Lee told a press conference in Melbourne. "It has turned out to be a very successful arrangement. I don't see that as being unfriendly". Thailand's prime minister claimed last month that the concert promoter AEG informed him of the subsidies being offered by the Singaporean government worth US\$2m - \$3m (£1.6m -£2.4m), as a part of an exclusivity government agreement. Singapore's previously said it had given Swift a grant to

play in the city-state, without mentioning the terms of the deal.

However, on Tuesday, Lee confirmed that Swift was provided with "certain incentives" from a government fund established to rebuild tourism after the pandemic, but did not say how much the deal would cost. Some south-east Asian neighbours have complained they have been deprived of the tourist boom that her concerts

"Sometimes one country makes a deal." sometimes another country does. I did not explicitly say "you will come here only on the condition that you'll not go to other places," Lee said. He added that Australia also made some "mutually acceptable, sensible arrangements" with Swift when she performed in Sydney and Melbourne before flying to Singapore, and added that he did not know what those arrangements were.

Unfair or fair, the contract seemed to have worked in the favour of Singapore. Swifties from the Philippines, Thailand, China, and other countries were seen rushing to Singapore. According to a report in CNN, 70 percent of the concert goers flew in from overseas and spent \$370 million in the city state.

But from the looks of it, all the money in the world cannot fix the broken hearts of the dejected fans who were unable to cash in on this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity and watch her perform in Singapore.



For the last few NCAA women's basketball seasons, Caitlin Clark has been phenomenal, breaking records and dominating the college game. This weekend, Caitlin Clark and Iowa suffered a loss in the women's national championship game on Sunday, falling to the number one overall seed South Carolina at 87-75. The Gamecocks completed a perfect 38-0 season, becoming the 10th perfect team in Division 1 of women's basketball history. The top-seeded Iowa team reached the NCAA title game for the second consecutive season, finishing the season 34-5. Clark concludes her collegiate career with 3951 points, averaging 31.6 points per game this season and 28.4 over 139 career games.

In a remarkable seventeen-day span from February 15th to March 3rd, Clark shattered records, surpassing Kelsey Plum to become the NCAA Division 1 scoring leader and an all-time college scoring record holder, surpassing Pete Maravich for the most career points in D1 history among both men and women. NBA superstar LeBron James recently tweeted, "If you don't rock with Caitlin Clark's game you're just a FLAT OUT HATER!!!! Stay far away from them people!! PLEASE," paying tribute to Clark's stellar college career and showing her respect despite her team's second finals loss. Following the final, South Carolina's Dawn Staley commended the Iowa Hawkeyes on an incredible season and expressed her admiration for Clark, labeling her as one of the greatest of all time in the game of basketball.



Clark will now become the first overall pick in the WNBA draft, joining the Indiana Fever for the upcoming season. After the final, she shared her college experience, talking with the rejoicing feeling of being someone who spent a good while on the court and was content with the outcome. "Whether it's the way the fans have supported me, the way I've been able to represent my state where I grew up or how my family was there at every single game – there's no regret in my mind about how things went," Clark said. "I'll be able to sleep every night even though I never won a national championship."

Despite being a college game, the final between Iowa and South Carolina was one of the most viewed sporting events in ESPN history, indicating the impact and popularity players like Clark have sparked worldwide. Bhatia fulfilled the wish he made to his mother years ago with this win. He shared with the media, "It's hard to win out there unlike how it is showed today. My mom's birthday was April 1, and her wish was to go to the Masters."





Bhatia started the day four shots ahead of Denny and extended his lead to six. However, a stunning back-nine rally by McCarthy left the two players tied at 20 under par after 72 holes. Akshay then produced a 12-foot birdie to force a playoff and made the next birdie on the first extra hole to register an impressive wire-to-wire victory.

In tennis, Sumit Nagal, an Indian tennis player, had a stellar year. In January, Nagal upset Alexander Bublik to reach the second round of the Australian Open for the first time, after successfully coming through the qualifying stages. In February, he broke into the top 100 after winning the ATP Challenger event in Chennai. This weekend, Nagal became the first Indian man to qualify at the

Monte Carlo Masters since 1982, and soon this 26-year-old topped that feat by becoming the first Indian to win a main-draw match in the open era on clay. Nagal rallied to defeat Matteo Arnaldi, recovering from losing an early break advantage in the decider to eventually close out the Italian for his first Masters 1000 match win. "I didn't take the chances that I had in the first set; he was the better player. But talking about the last two sets, I have nothing to complain about. Very, very good quality from me," Nagal reflected on his performance in the match with Prakash Amritaj. He also shared with the audience how he began playing on clay from a young age and fell in love with the surface, as it gives him extra confidence. With this win, he currently

ranks at a career-high of 93, up from 509 last year. The New Delhi native also revealed how he only had 900 euros in his bank account last September, as he was returning from hip surgery. Now, as he moves on to the second round, he will face his biggest career challenge as he takes on the seventh seed Holger Rune, a match that many people from around the world anticipate and hope to witness. More history is to be written as the tournament progresses.

As Akshay Bhatia prepares to make his debut at the Masters and Sumit Nagal continues to make waves in the tennis world, their stories serve as inspiration for aspiring athletes everywhere. Their dedication, perseverance, and unwavering belief in their abilities have propelled them to new heights, and as they continue to write their chapters in the history of sport, they remind us all of the power of dreams and the importance of never giving up on them.
